#### **Quoted Prices**

1) All prices indicated are in New Zealand Dollars (NZD). Where possible an amount may be indicated in your home currency. Due to foreign exchange rates changing we strongly recommend that you check your banks exchange rate before making a payment. Three Islands NZ Ltd can only confirm quotes based in New Zealand Dollars and this is what you will need to pay to complete your booking. #### **Payment Options:**

We will then send you an invoice for 25 percent of the total booking price (a non-refundable deposit). Full payment (the remainder) is due within 60 days of your arrival in New Zealand (or 60 days prior to the use of a service we provide). - 3) If a booking is made less than 60 days before tour commencement, then payment is required in full at the time of confirming your booking. We will send you an invoice which will need to be paid within 5 days.
- 4) All prices are quoted in NZ dollars unless otherwise specified. Prices include New Zealand Goods and Services Tax at 15%. Payment can be made by Paypal, direct bank (telegraphic) transfers or credit card. Payments made by credit card will incur a transaction fee of 2%.

## **Cancellation of Booking**

5) It is recommended that you take out travel insurance covering cancellation. In the event of a cancellation 30 to 60 days prior to tour commencement, we will refund 50% of the package price. In the event of a cancellation 29 days or less prior to tour commencement, there will be no refund. This cancellation policy is subject to change during peak season and special events, in this case you will be notified prior to confirmation of booking.

## Changes or Cancellation by Us

6) Before you enter into a contract with us, we reserve the right to change any of the facilities, services or prices described in our itinerary or on our website. It is highly unlikely we will have to make any changes to your holiday and any changes will usually be very minor.
